Adele "Someone Like You" - Listening Activity

1. Elicit vocab "lyrics", "verse", "chorus", "bridge". OPTIONAL: Brief discussion on "rhyming" in English songs (not all countries / language cultures rhyme song lyrics as standard).
2. Handout the student lyric sheet. Draw attention to the **bold** being the chorus. Explain that they will listen to "someone like you" and should fill in the missing words in the verse and chorus, and find the *incorrect* words in the chorus.
3. Play song once.
4. Give students a few minutes to compare their answers.
5. Play song a second time.
6. Go through each line eliciting student answers then revealing the correct answers.
7. Play song a third time for students to listen for the correct words.
8. Give the students the following questions. OPTIONAL: Can be done as a jigsaw activity.

"Look at the lyrics again.

- **What do you think the song is about?**
 - **Who is she singing to?**
 - **What is their relationship?**
 - **What was their relationship?**
 - **What does she want?**
 - **What do you think he might want?"**
9. Students share answers, giving examples from the lyrics to show why they think so.
 10. Give students the final questions. Check comprehension and confirm that the experience does not have to be *identical*.
 - **Do you know someone who has had a similar experience? What happened?**
 - **What's the best way to get over a broken heart?**
 11. Students share answers.
